South Louisiana Coastal Bank Business Services Scholarship

Establishment

L. E. Fletcher Technical Community College hereby agrees to establish the South Louisiana Coastal Bank Business Services Scholarship for the terms of this agreement. This fund is established initially from South Louisiana Bank.

Purpose of the Scholarship

The purpose of the this scholarship is to provide financial assistance to a deserving full-time student majoring in the Office Systems Technology or the Accounting Technology Associate Degree or Diploma programs at L. E. Fletcher Technical Community College. Student recipient must enroll or be enrolled in classes and make consistent progress toward his or her degree or diploma program.

Amount and Method of Payment

The scholarship is being established as a two-year scholarship from the South Louisiana Bank. The scholarship entitles the recipient(s) to funds for tuition only.

Criteria for Selection

The selection criteria for the South Louisiana Bank Scholarship are as follows:

1. The recipient must be an enrollee who plans to major in Office Systems Technology or Accounting Technology at L. E. Fletcher Technical Community College.
2. The recipient must be enrolled as a full-time student at L.E. Fletcher Technical Community College. (A full-time student is defined as a student enrolled in 12 or more hours of credit courses.)
3. The recipient may keep this scholarship for 2 years (4 semesters) provided he or she meets all the above criteria and maintains a 3.0 overall grade point average.
4. Demonstrate financial need.
5. If recipient is receiving other student financial aid, this scholarship cannot exceed the cost of attendance.

Selection Process

L. E. Fletcher Technical Community College will administer The South Louisiana Bank Scholarship on behalf of the South Louisiana Bank. The College Scholarship Committee will make the selection of the scholarship recipient(s). The recipient’s academic progress toward completion of the diploma or associate degree will be monitored each semester. Should the student change his/her major or fall below the required grade point average, the scholarship will be made available to other qualified students.

Donor Appreciation

News Articles. A news article announcing the South Louisiana Bank Scholarship will be featured in the *Fletcher Voice*, the quarterly Student Government publication and other college publications. In addition, a news release and picture announcing the scholarship will be sent to newspapers in Terrebonne, Lafourche, surrounding parishes, and the recipient(s) parish(es) of residence.

Handbook and Website. The South Louisiana Bank Scholarship will be listed in the scholarship section of the Fletcher *Catalog & Handbook* and will also be included on the Fletcher Website.
